Your Book Program

Books for your Bag – If you attended the September and October Club meetings, you received your new ‘tutor identifier’ - a handy royal blue tote bag with the new TfK tag line.

So, what to do with your bag? Please fill it with books for the students that you tutor. Set up a system that you will use to help them **“earn” one book a month.**

How to Get Books for your Bag – Two easy ways:

1. Attend the monthly club meetings – either Villages or Belleview Library.
2. Call to set a time to come and get them from Carolyn and Frank’s house - 352-245-9709

Books for the Break – Twice a year we give books to every student in the class where you tutor -before December holiday break and before end of the school year.

All tutors must come to get books for their class. If more than one tutor is in a classroom, your STC can help identify which one will pick up books. More info will come from your STCs in November. Pick-up dates will be in the November newsletter. We will start this pickup on Monday, November 21.

Still Need Book Captains! What is a Book Captain?

The current inventory is over 15,000 books. We have committed to distribute over 20,000 books this school year.

Several schools have committed storage space. **So, we need at least two people at each school to be ‘book captains’** for Wildwood Elementary, Villages, Fruitland Park, Leesburg, Beverly Shores, and Stanton Weirsdale.
